1. There were no minutes to approve from last meeting.
2. Treasurer's report - received \$1000 from A-Plus for Casino Night, \$1400 from Catalyst for mock exams.
We paid \$300 for math team ride.
We approved the two \$1000 scholarships and \$1000 senior class gift.
We refunded \$150 a parent that bought tickets twice for Casino Night.
3. BOE report – Sub hired for business administrative, building at Bryan school is ahead of schedule.
4. KPA update – at last meeting they discussed graduation scholarships, KPA divides their scholarship money to several smaller sums.
5. Parent speaker series – 3/14spring event was together with 6th grade parent orientation night and was very good. HAS had table with brochures.

7. Mock SAT/ACT were very successful, almost at capacity. We made \$1,400.
